## CEMETERY FEES

with effect from 1 Feb 2014

(Parish Cemetery)

Fees for parishioners (including Army personnel from Bassingbourn Barracks):

Lawn grave (without kerbs or ledger/slab):

Purchase of burial plot and 40 years exclusive right of burial	£210
40 years memorial rights for simple one-part or two-part headstone	Included

Grave with full memorial (including kerbs or ledger/slab):

Purchase of burial plot and 40 years exclusive right of burial	£210
40 years memorial rights for full memorial with headstone and kerb or ledger/slab	£ 50

Half-size lawn grave for ashes:

Purchase of burial plot and 40 years exclusive right of burial	£105
40 years memorial rights for simple one-part or two-part headstone	Included

Garden of Remembrance:

First interment fee	£ 50
Brass plaque for Chapel wall	£ 65

Reduced fees for burial plots purchased prior to May 1996:

First interment fee	£ 65
40 years memorial rights	£ 20
Fee for vase	£ 12

Second interment (for any of the above):

Interment fee	£ 50
Memorial fee for additional inscription	£ 12

Other fees:

Renewal of 40 years exclusive right of burial 50% of current exclusive right of burial fee	
Administration fee for surrender or transfer of exclusive rights 20% of current exclusive right of burial fee	
Renewal of 40 years memorial rights	£ 25

Fees are set by Bassingbourn-cum-Kneesworth Parish Council Cemetery Committee and are subject to change.

Fees for non-parishioners are charged at twice the rate for parishioners.

Cemetery Regulations made under the Local Authorities Cemetery Orders 1977 apply to this cemetery. A copy of the current Cemetery Regulations may be obtained from the Clerk to the Parish Council.

All memorials are subject to approval by the Cemetery Committee. The Cemetery is open to the public during daylight hours.
